The XPI serves as a leading indicator of board performance. It utilizes a set of formulas to express a relative range of performance. It is the output of a set of comprehensive, yet easy to use board performance assessments. Two of three assessments are already mandated by the SEC in some form, providing an easy solution for fulfilling regulatory compliance. When the associated support tools and processes are fully deployed, XPI provides an exceptionally valuable measure of the board's progress toward delivering sustainable long-term shareowner value.

## XPI Components:

The XPI consists of several key assessment tools, which are tightly integrated into a single evaluation process. Consistent with all products and services within XCEO's portfolio of offerings, the XPI is based on the concept of "SCIENCE".
